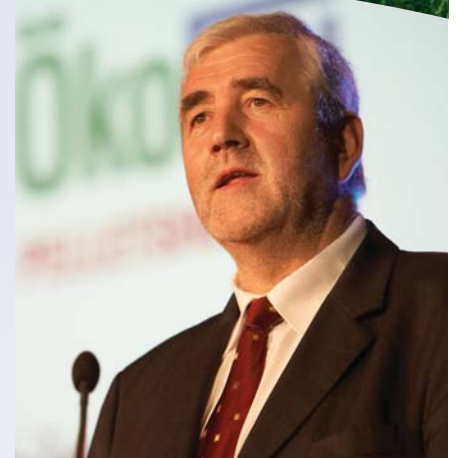
From the South:
